Curriculum Corner

In math, we are working on module 3. In module 3 students are learning about multi-digit multiplication and division. This week students worked on division. Students practiced long division with remainders, area models, place value charts, and arrays.

In reading, we are working on unit 1. In unit 1 we are reading a book called *The Tiger Rising*. *The Tiger Rising* is being used to guide instruction.

In writing, we officially starting our second unit (realistic fiction/narrative) this week.

This week we continued our first science unit on Energy Conversions. Students are taking on the role of systems engineers to help a town called Ergstown. Students are investigating this question: What happened to the electrical system the night of the Ergstown black-out?

We are doing social emotional learning (SEL) every Wednesday.
