Curriculum Corner

In math, we completed module 2. In this short five lesson module students learned about unit conversions and problem solving with metric measurement. Students completed the End of Module 2 Assessment on Wednesday. This week we also started Module 3. In Module 3 students are going to learn about multi-digit multiplication and division.

In reading, we took a short break on unit 1. In unit 1 we are reading a book called *The Tiger Rising*. The Tiger Rising is being used to guide instruction in unit 1. This week we did some F&P testing and a reading response. Students were tested on reading fluency, accuracy, and comprehension.

In writing, we continued our opinion writing unit this week. Students continued the drafting process.

In social studies, we completed our first social studies unit about Washington's Earliest Times this week. Students completed the End of Social Studies Unit I Assessment on Monday and Tuesday. We also started our first science unit on energy conversions this week!

We are doing social emotional learning (SEL) every Wednesday. This Wednesday we learned all about understanding different perspectives.
