Curriculum Corner

In math, we are working on Module 3. In Module 3 students are learning about multi-digit multiplication and division. This week students worked on multi -digit multiplication.

In reading, we are working on unit 1. In unit 1 we are reading a book called *The Tiger Rising*. *The Tiger Rising* is being used to guide instruction in unit 1. This week we officially launched reading small groups. Students completed a reading response, I -Ready reading lessons, independent reading and met with me for a mini-lesson in stations.

In writing, we continued our opinion writing unit this week. Students continued the drafting process. Students used the Opinion Writing Checklist to edit/revise their work.

This week we started our first science unit on Energy Conversions. Students are taking on the role of systems engineers to help a town called Ergstown. Students are investigating this question: What happened to the electrical system the night of the Ergstown blackout?
